Please note that any one project may consist of more than one of the above fees. For example, a new sewer lateral will likely consist of a sewer line fee, a curb and gutter fee, a sidewalk fee, a street excavation fee and a sewer tap fee.

In addition to the hookup fee, the person requesting a new connection shall pay for the actual cost incurred by the city for the water meter installed as part of the connection.

Development Projects: For all development projects, engineering permit fees equal 2% of the cost for the entire project.

Above fees are taken from Ordinance No. 2009-43 which amended section 4-6-1.A of the municipal code.

Ogden City Engineering ROW Permit - Fee Illustration

ROW Defined:
Includes city streets, curb & gutter, park strips, sidewalks (if present) and most often extends 6-12" past the edge of the sidewalk. Because ROW widths may differ from street to street, please contact the city Engineering Division (801-629-8990) to verify ROW location and width.



*** Concrete Replacement:** Ogden City Standards require that all concrete sidewalk or curb & gutter panels damaged or removed during the course of a job be **replaced in their entirety** with new concrete.

**** Utility Taps:** Typically a utility tap is installed at the time of initial construction, or when an existing tap is damaged beyond functionality. This is not a common repair item.
