## APRIL IS FAIR HOUSING MONTH

Each April, we come together as a community and a nation to celebrate the anniversary of the passing of the Fair Housing Act and recommit to the goal to eliminate housing discrimination and create equal opportunity in every community.

Fair housing means our communities are open and welcoming, free from housing discrimination and hostility. It means each one of us, regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, familial status, and disability has access to neighborhoods of opportunity where our children can attend quality schools, our environment allows us to be healthy, and where economic opportunities and self-sufficiency can grow.

## SEWER BACKUPS CAN BE UGLY AND COSTLY

A sewer backup will usually start in the basement in the lowest drain in your house. If you see water backing up, turn off all running water immediately and call Ogden City Utility at 801-629-8331.

Homeowners are responsible for maintenance, repair, and cleaning of the sewer lateral that runs from the home to the main line in the street; the City is responsible for the main line and your connection to that line. If a blockage is found to be on your side of the sewer, City personnel can direct you to a local plumber or roofer service.

The only things you should ever flush down a toilet are human waste and toilet paper. Even though some products such as wipes and baby diapers claim to be flushable, they aren't.

Never flush disposable diapers, feminine hygiene products, cotton balls or swabs, contraceptives, cleaning wipes or paper towels, facial tissue, bandages or bandage wrappings, automotive fluids, paint, solvents, sealants, and thinners, cooking grease or oils, poisons, medications, or hazardous waste.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: EARTHQUAKE SAFETY

Each year, large earthquakes damage property and threaten lives. We are far overdue for a large magnitude earthquake and when it happens the system will be overwhelmed and we must be prepared.

Prepare for an earthquake by following these steps: Move or secure things that could fall on you. • Ensure your water heater and other major appliances are strapped down appropriately and have flexible connectors. • Be ready to move away from windows, which can break during an earthquake. • Store emergency supplies. • Learn the emergency procedures at work, home, and school. • Register for CODE RED on our website for emergency notifications.
