

## DON'T GET BURNED THIS FIREWORKS SEASON



Plan for safe holiday celebrations if you wish to use fireworks. Keep at least 30 feet from any residence, dwelling, structure, tree, power line, or overhead obstruction. Be aware of wind speed and direction before igniting aerial devices. Once ignited, aerial devices will continue to fire each shot until all shots are spent. You will be held responsible if your fireworks start a fire. Do not use

illegal fireworks: firecrackers, m-80s, cherry bombs, bottle rockets, roman candles, mortars, or ground salutes.

## EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: SUMMER LIGHTNING

Lightning can strike at any time if all the conditions are just right.

Plan in advance your evacuation and safety measures. • When you first see lightning or hear thunder, activate your emergency plan. • Avoid water, high ground, open spaces, and all metal objects, including electric wires, fences, machinery, motors, power tools, etc. Unsafe places include underneath canopies, small picnic or rain shelters, or near trees. • Where possible, find shelter in a substantial building or in a fully enclosed metal vehicle with the windows completely shut. • If lightning is striking nearby when you are outside, you should crouch down, put your feet together, and place your hands over your ears to minimize hearing damage from thunder. • Stay at least 15 feet away from other people. • Stay away from doors and windows. • Turn off, unplug, and stay away from appliances, computers, telephones, and TV sets. • Suspend activities for 30 minutes after the last observed lightning or thunder.
