BE AWARE OF SCHOOL ZONES

Ogden City School District's first day is August 23. Please be aware of school zones and cross walks as you drive on the streets around town. Obey these simple rules to help ensure all of our children arrive safely.

1. Vehicles are required to slow at the flashing speed-reduction sign.
2. If a crosswalk is occupied, vehicles are required to stop. They must also stop prior to the crosswalk if another vehicle has stopped prior to the crosswalk; it is against the law to pass any vehicle stopped at a school crosswalk.
3. The speed limit returns to the normal posted speed at the "end of school zone sign." If there is no such sign, the speed returns to the normal posted limit at the speed reduction sign posted for the opposite direction you're traveling.

WIPE OUT GRAFFITI IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

Graffiti, gang related or otherwise, has a negative effect on citizens' feelings of safety. It creates the perception that crime is unchecked in the area. Graffiti sends a signal that people just don't care, which in turn attracts other forms of crime and delinquency to the neighborhood. Contact the Graffiti Task Force Investigation Unit (801-629-8752) to report incidents of graffiti vandalism or to relay any information about suspects. All information is kept confidential. To report graffiti crimes in progress, call 911 immediately.

Tips to keep your neighborhood graffiti-free:

- Take a picture of the graffiti before it is removed. Photographs will assist law enforcement in their investigation.
- Adopt a spot in your neighborhood and ensure it stays clean and free of graffiti.
- Add or improve lighting around your property to promote natural surveillance and report street lights that are not working.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: CYBER ATTACKS

Follow these tips to stay safe on the Internet.

- Only connect to the Internet over secure, password-protected networks.
- Do not click on links or pop-ups, open attachments, or respond to emails from strangers.
- Do not respond to online requests for Personally Identifiable Information (PII).
- Password protect all devices that connect to the Internet and user accounts.

If you're under attack:

- Disconnect your device from the internet
- Update your anti-virus software (if possible) and perform a manual scan of your entire system, install appropriate patches.



If you believe your Personally Identifiable Information (PII-information that can be used to uniquely identify, contact, or locate a single person) is compromised:

- Immediately change all passwords; financial passwords first.
- Close any accounts that may have been compromised. Watch for any unexplainable or unauthorized charges to your accounts.
